

Definition: any access entrance onto property that abuts an Alfred Town road or right of way, which will serve as temporary or permanent access for forestry operations, residential and commercial construction projects, shall meet the following construction and maintenance requirements.

- 1) Entrance location shall be approved by the Alfred Road Commissioner, prior to construction of the entrance.
- 2) Access entrance shall be a minimum of twenty feet wide and a properly sized culvert shall be added, if required, as prescribed by the Road Commissioner. Town of Alfred is not responsible for any cost associated with the access entrance, culvert or other drainage issues related to the access entrance.
- 3) The access entrance shall be forty feet long, if the access is for forestry operations, with a surface of two and three inch stone which shall cover the entire length and width of the access.
- 4) The entrance and entrance way shall be maintained, so that, no mud, silt, rocks or dirt is tracked on to the Town road. Sweeping shall be required on paved roads. Regarding forestry operations, a ditch that was filled to create the access shall be required to be re-established to pre-construction state.
- 5) Repair to Town roads and/or property, including but not limited to pavement, is the responsibility of the property owner and/or the company hired to perform the work.
- 6) The approved permit is required prior to any forestry operations or land development.
