



Town of Alfred How Do I ... ?



Pay Property Taxes

The first installment is due by 10/1 and the 2nd installment is due 4/1. If you are a new property owner, and purchased after April 1, you will need to contact the Town office for your property bill. All property bills are available online. Visit alfred.com/ Tax Collector. You can also pay your property taxes online at <https://epayment.informe.org/pay-portonline/disclaimer/1332>



Get a Transfer Station Sticker

The Town office and the Transfer Station have stickers. You must show proof of residency or ownership in Alfred. The Transfer Station is open: Tues 12:00-7:45 pm, Thursday 2:00-5:45 pm and Saturday 8:00 am to 3:45 pm.



Get Mail

You will need to provide proof of residency or ownership, and bring that to the Alfred Post Office to get a post office box or mail delivery in your area.



Get a Driver's License

This must be done at the Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV). For information on what to bring to the BMV and locations, visit maine.gov/sos/bmv



Register a Vehicle

This can be done at the town office in Alfred as long as you live in Alfred. You must register your vehicle in the Town where you reside. Visit alfred.com/ Tax Collector for the most up to date information. Vanity Plates: You will need to register at the Town office, then order vanity plates online. Get an Inspection Sticker

After your car has been registered, book an appointment at a local garage that is an authorized inspection station.



Register ATV/trailer/etc.

Maine residents can do this at the town office or online. You must bring in some information on the machine such as, current registration, VIN #, old sticker number and year of expiration. New registration needs a bill of sale. Nonresidents can register online at:

Get a Hunting/Fishing License

These can be obtained at an authorized MOSES agent (Town Hall). Hunting/fishing licenses can be obtained online from Maine Department of Inland Fisheries & Wildlife (MDIFW) at https://moses.informe.org/cgi-bin/online/moses_v3/index or at participating Walmart, Cabela's stores, or a Town office. Please bring a form of picture I.D. to prove residency.



Get a Concealed Carry License

Not required in the State of Maine.



Get Sand for Winter

For Alfred residents only. Sand can be taken in two 5 gallon buckets per household per storm located at the Transfer Station.



Get Transit Plates

You can visit your local Town office or Bureau of Motor Vehicles. Not all Town offices participate in issuing transit plates. You should call ahead.
