- \$1.00 charge for tires with rims

~Michigan Department of Environmental Quality grant rules limit 10 tires per household/business~

~There will be a charge of \$2.00 for each tire beyond 10 per household/business~

~Farmers are allowed 1 tractor tire for free~

- White Goods (appliances, water heaters, etc) - One freon unit per household free - additional freon units \$10.00 each
- Furniture, mattresses/boxsprings. (Any combination of two mattresses or box springs are free - after two mattresses or box springs, the cost is \$10.00 each)

ALL OTHER ITEMS - FEES WILL APPLY

No cleaners, aerosols, solvents, paint, automotive cleaners, light bulbs, fertilizer
