






3-on-3 Basketball:

Half court competition, NCAA tournament rules. ENTER AS TEAMS - NO INDIVIDUAL APPLICATIONS ACCEPTED. Uniforms with numbers required. Single sex teams with max 9 members. Age divisions determined by age of youngest member. Send applications with a team roster and name of team. NO ROSTER CHANGES AFTER AUGUST 26.



Billiards:

An eight ball tournament will be held in each age/sex division. Tournament directors may combine divisions if necessary. Four 8-foot & 1 9-foot tables will be used. Personal use sticks must be used. Bowling:

At Woodbridge Bowling Center, squads are on 9/9 and 9/10 at 10 AM, Noon, or 2 PM. An entrant may bowl once in singles and multi times in doubles with different partners. For the doubles, age classification shall be of the youngest partner. Contestants previously entered in the bowling event may re-enter on site in another squad based on lane availability. Bowlers must pay the bowling center a \$6 lineage fee prior to each squad in which they participate. Certified with the US Bowling Congress (USBC) each contestant must have a current membership card or receipt for the 2022-2023 season. You may also purchase a USBC participation fee for \$5. 





You must be 50 years of age as of December 31, 2022, to register.

Our goal is to run the tournament all round robin format. Your competition age bracket may or may not be the same as your sign-up bracket. Combining and splitting of brackets is at the discretion of the Tournament Director.

Search for "NJ Senior Olympics" (case sensitive) Pickleball players may only register in 2 of the 5 events offered. The fee will be \$40 collected on that site. PayPal and all major credit/debit card are accepted.



All Roads Lead to Woodbridge

To Woodbridge Community Center

GSP North: Exit 127 to Rt. 9 North. Bear right From the Community Center make left onto at the Speedway Gas Station to take the Rt. 514 exit and make a left onto Main St. (Rt. 514 West). Third light, right into CC.

GSP South: Take exit 130 to Rt. 1 North, take Rt. 1 for a half mile. Take a right onto Woodbridge Center Dr. Fourth light, right onto Main St. (Rt. 514 West). Right at next light into CC.

NJ Turnpike: Take exit 10. Bear left and follow signs for Rt. 287 North, but do not take Rt. 287. Take exit on the right for Rt. 514 East (Woodbridge/ Fords). Go 7 traffic lights, then take left at Antares Dr. to enter the CC.

Rt. 287: Take 287 South, past the Turnpike. Take exit on right for Rt. 514 East (Woodbridge/Fords). Go through seven traffic lights, then turn left at Antares Dr.

From Warren Park to Cypress Rec, Center in Port Reading

Exit Warren Park, make left onto King Georges Rd. continue to traffic light, make left onto Amboy Ave.(RT 35 N), at the 5th light turn right onto Main St. continue on Main and bear left at the monument onto Rahway Ave. at 2nd light turn right onto Port Reading Rd. continue on to 2nd light, turn onto West Ave. Cypress Recreation Center is on the left.

To Woodbridge Bowling Center

GSP North: Exit 127 to Route 9 North to Main St. (514 W), right after overpass into bowling center.

GSP South: Exit 129 to Route 9 North, follow above.

To Woodbridge HS

GSP North: Exit 127 to Rt. 9 North to Rt. 35 South left third light.

To Warren Park from Community Center

Main St. Continue on Main St. to Amboy Ave. and that is Route 35 South. Fourth traffic light make right and stay on Route 35 South to Florida Grove Rd. Take fourth light and turn right and Warren Park is on right.

From NJTP Exit 10: Route 287 East toward Outerbridge Crossing to Rt. 35 North. Left on Florida Grove Rd. Park is on right.

To Ash Brook Golf Course, Scotch Plains

From Points North: Follow Garden State Parkway South to exit 135. Take exit 135 towards Clark/Westfield. Turn right on Central Ave. Take Central Ave and make the second left onto Raritan Rd. Turn right on Westfield Ave. Take 2nd right to stay on Westfield Ave. Take 2nd left on Lamberts Mill Rd. Turn left on Raritan Rd, bear left to stay Raritan Rd, course will be on your left.

From Points South: Follow Garden State Parkway North to exit 135. Take Central Ave left under parkway. Take Central Ave and make the second left onto Raritan Rd. Turn right on Westfield Ave. Take 2nd right to stay on Westfield Ave. Take 2nd left on Lamberts Mill Rd. Turn left on Raritan Rd, bear left to stay Raritan Rd, course will be on your left.

From Points West: Follow Route 22 East to Terrill Rd. Make a right on Terrill Rd. Follow Terrill Rd to Raritan Rd. Make a right on Raritan Rd, course will be on your left.

To Frank Pelzman Park, Avenel

From the Community Center make left onto Main St., continue on Main to Amboy Ave. at that light make the left onto Amboy Ave (Rt. 35) and continue aprox 1 mile and take the exit for Rt 1&9 North.

Within 1000 feet make right on Tappen St. and Pelzman Park will be on the right in 2-3 blocks.
