



TOWN OF ALTAVISTA WEEKEND TRUCK RENTAL GUIDELINES

One truck per residential or business address is available for the weekend rental by residents, property owners and businesses of the Town to dispose of standard residential/business waste or brush. Items not permitted are listed below. The rental truck is typically scheduled to arrive on the Friday prior to the weekend it is rented. The Town will remove the truck up on the first business day following the weekend rental. See Town of Altavista's Master List of Fees, Rates and Charges for associated costs.

Please note the following:

- Single axle and tandem axle trucks are available. Use type requested based on estimated gross weight of waste.
- Truck availability is limited November 1st through April 1st
- The truck will only be parked in one place on property and locked during the entire time it is parked
- This service is only available for businesses that have a commercial/business waste management service contracted for the business address
- Property cleanouts, such as after a tenant vacates a property, are subject to a security deposit
- Trucks are rented and charged per load based on the appropriate rate category
- Weekday rentals are permitted but requests shall be reserved only for holidays and/or emergency situations
- This service is not available industrial businesses
- This service is not designated for land clearing, tree trunk removal, or stump removal

Materials hauled by the Town must be permitted by the Region 2000 Services Authority (the "landfill"). Items not permitted will be at borrower's risk and cost. A load is limited to four (4) tires only and must be loaded last, so they are visible to the Town employee.

For health and safety reasons, the following items are not allowed to dispose of on the truck. If you have questions about permissible items, please call the Town for additional guidance.

- Waste Oil, Oil Tanks, or Gas Cylinders
- Batteries of any type or style
- Liquids of any kind
- Paints and/or Paint Cans
- Waste Chemicals or Radioactive Material
- Asphalt Roofing Shingles
- Flammable or Explosive Material
- Ashes
- Feces or Animal Carcasses
- Medical or Pathological Waste

As a voluntary service offered by the Town, there are no assurances or guarantees a truck will be available on a given weekend. Service will be provided on a first come, first served basis if calls are received by Wednesday of that week. Applicants who are unable to rent a truck on a given weekend will be placed at the head of the list for the following weekend provided the truck is not already scheduled for use. Prior to the Town of Altavista accepting the application for rental of the "weekend truck" by a resident or business, per Town Policy Number T-85-3 "*Authorization Policy RE: Operating Town Equipment on Privately Owned Property*" the Town requires the following:

- That the owner(s) of the property, where the work is to be performed, sign and date the Town's Application including the authorization entitled "Authorization to Operate Town Equipment on Privately Owned Property"
- That all Real Estate and Personal Property taxes as well as any delinquent water/sewer bills due the Town of Altavista be brought current and all money due is to be paid in full.

The authorization form(s), rental fee, and any delinquent taxes and/or utility bills must be completed and paid-in-full by the close-of-business on the Wednesday before the Friday the truck is scheduled for placement/delivery.

Applicants must indicate the specific location for the vehicle to be parked. If the applicant is not on-site at the time of truck arrival the truck will be placed at the discretion of the Town. Once parked and locked it will remain so until picked up by the Town. Applicants seeking an exception to this may contact the Director of Public Works and requests will be reviewed on a case-to-case basis.
