

Fare Policy

A fare of fifty cents (\$.50) per trip is charged and must be paid when boarding the bus. A trip is (1) one complete route, (2) when a rider exits

and gets back on the bus with the exception at Town Hall when paying a bill, the rider may get back on at no charge. Exact change is required. Tokens, Monthly Passes and Punch Cards are also accepted and may be purchased at Town Hall.

Cash fare per person: 50¢

10 punch pass:

- 1 for \$4
- 3 for \$10

Monthly Pass: \$20

Return fare from Hurt Medical Center: \$1

Service Accessibility

This bus is equipped with a wheelchair lift for the people with disabilities or those who require assistance. Please ask the driver for help if you need assistance when boarding.

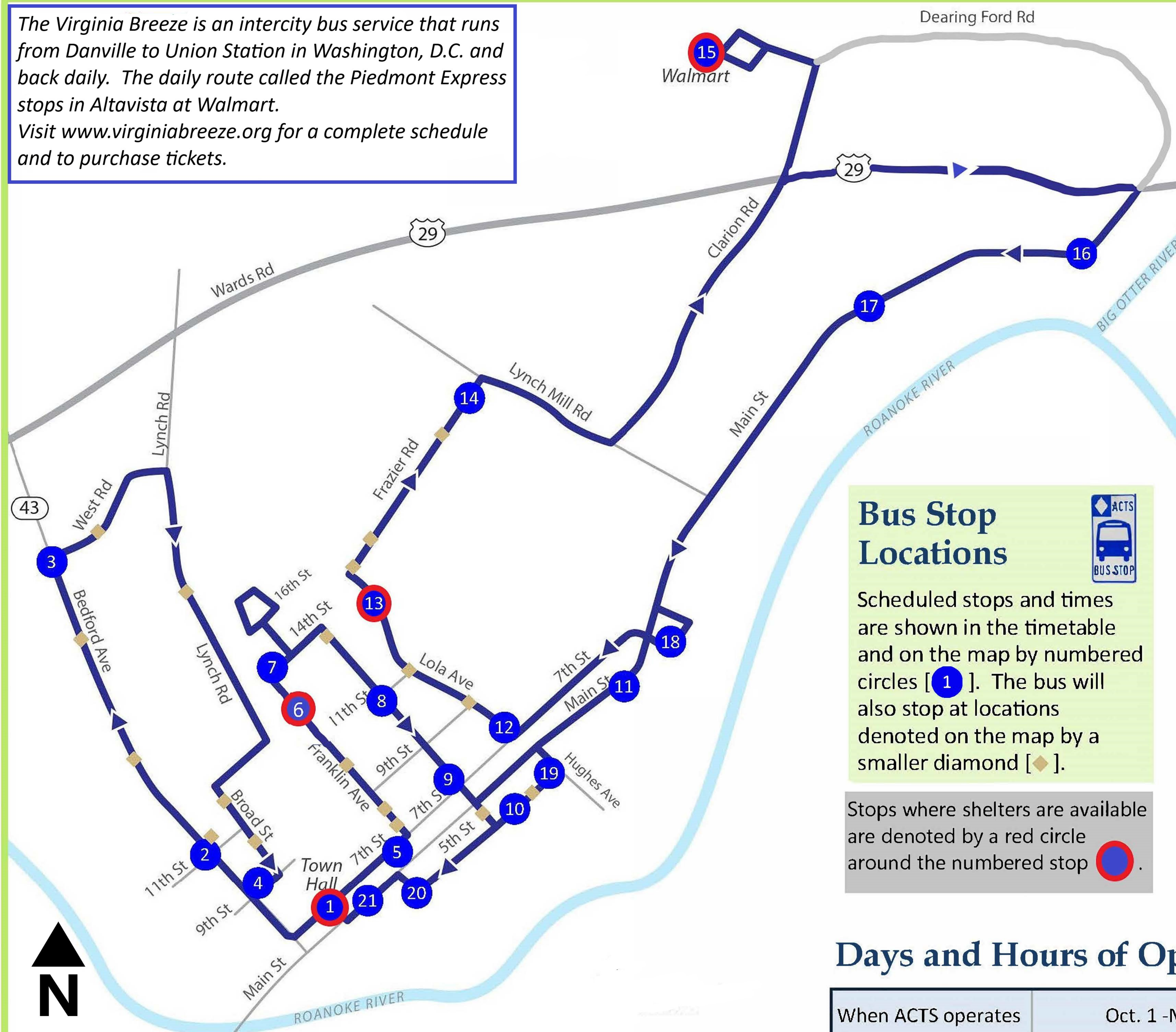

Route Deviation Service

Individuals may request the bus to deviate off its route to make pick-ups or drop offs. This service requires a 24-hour advanced notice and can be scheduled by calling 434-369-5001. This distance of deviation may not exceed 3/4 of a mile off the route and must be within the Town limits with the exception of the Hurt Medical Center. Return fare is \$1.
