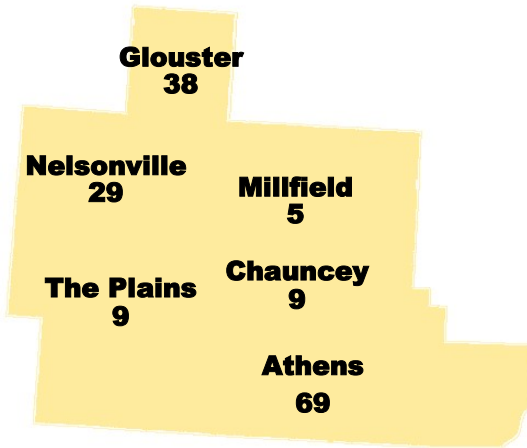


# Athens Reentry Program Stats



2017-2018



New intakes completed with Athens County Reentry Coordinator Shawn Stover during the years of 2017 and 2018 from 190 reentry participants. The information and graphs were compiled to create this overview.

This map of Athens county shows where most participants report as their area of residence. Below are communities that are not listed on the map and also have participants;

Albany(8), Amesville(4), Buchtel(2), Guysville(3), Jacksonville(5), New Marshfield(1), Stewart(6), and Trimble(2).

**57%**

of participants did not complete high school with the majority dropping out in the 11th and 12th grade.

**27%**

of participants without a High School Diploma have no GED.

**28%** of

participants are female and **81%** of them reported issues with substance abuse.



**25%**

of participants identified as homeless upon release and stay in shelters or in various places including friends when allowed.

**75%**

of participants are securely staying with family or friends.

**4%**

reported as being a veteran.

**79%**

are under some kind of supervision with the Adult Parole Authority upon release.

**77%**

do not have a valid drivers license and owe fines or fees.

**28%**

Owe child support arrears and are required to pay child support.



**71%**

reported issues with substance abuse just prior to legal issues.

**13%**

with substance abuse issues are currently in the vivitrol program

**54%**

are between the ages of 27-38. **17%** are over 45 years of age.
