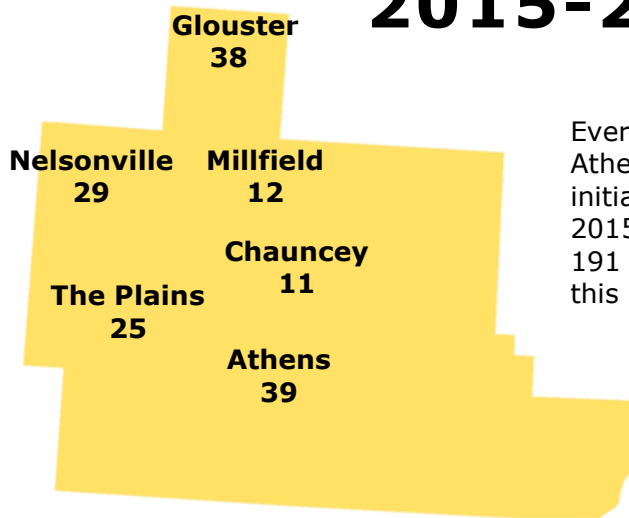


Reentry Program Participants 2015-2016



Every new client that participates in Job and Family Services' Athens Reentry Program completes an intake during their initial meeting with Reentry Coordinator Shawn Stover. In 2015-2016 intake information was self-reported by a total of 191 participant. That information had been compiled to create this overview.

This map of Athens county shows where the highest concentration of participants report residing. Each of these communities have 10 or less participants; Albany(5), Amesville(3), Buchtel(4), Guysville(3), Jacksonville(3), New Marshfield(4), Shade(1), Stewart(1), and Trimble(2).

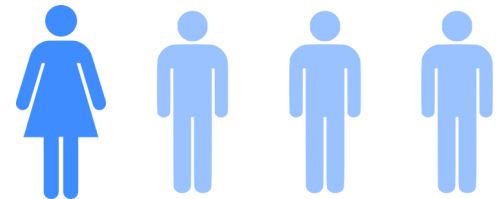
of participants did not complete high school with the majority dropping out in **11th and 12th** grade.
