Includes fires involving vegetative fuels, other than prescribed fire (632), that occur in an area in which development is essentially nonexistent, except for roads, railroads, power lines, and the like. Located at 14010 Spring Rd., Bentonville, AR.
- 4-9: Brush or brush-and-grass mixture fire. Includes ground fuels laying on or immediately



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above the ground such as duff, roots, dead leaves, fine dead wood, and downed logs at 7 Pinehurst Ln., Bella Vista, AR.
