- 8-22: Building Fire (Building fire. Excludes confined fires (113-118) at 135 Windfield Ln., Pineville, MO.
- 8-23: Outside equipment fire. Includes outside trash compactors, outside HVAC units, and irrigation pumps. Excludes special structures (110 series) and mobile construction equipment (130 series) at Riordan, Cunningham Corner, Bella Vista, AR.
- 8-26: Cooking fire, confined to container (fire involving the contents of a cooking vessel without fire extension beyond the vessel) at 3 Parkridge Dr.,
- 8-27: Brush or brush-and-grass mixture fire. Includes ground fuels lying on or immediately above the ground such as duff, roots, dead leaves, fine dead wood, and downed logs at 21 Sheneman Dr., Bella Vista, AR.
