- 7-8: Brush or brush-and- grass mixture fire. Includes ground fuels lying on or immediately above the ground at 43 Cullen Hills Dr., Bella Vista, AR. 7-14: Mutual given to 15737 Easterling Rd., Pea Ridge, AR. Patient transported to NW Medical Center, Bentonville, AR.
- 7-17: Cooking fire, confined to container at 22 Pease Dr., Bella Vista, AR.
- 7-20: Passenger vehicle fire. Includes any motorized passenger vehicle, other than a motor home (e.g. pickup trucks, sport utility vehicles, buses) at Rocky Dell Hollow Road & Butler Creek Rd. Bella Vista, AR.
- 7-21: Mutual aid given to Gravette FD at Hwy 549, Gravette, AR. Motor Vehicle accident with injuries. Patient transported to NW Medical Center, Bentonville, AR.

- Fires in structure other than in a building (included are fires on or in piers, quays, or pilings: tunnels or under- ground connecting structures; bridges, trestles, or overhead elevated structures; transformers, power or utility vaults or equipment. 2 Blowing Springs Rd., Bella Vista, AR.
