- 11-19: Chief Sims met with Bella Vista CTV to film at Station 3 regarding the bond issue.
- 11-20: Chief Sims spoke with Bella Vista CTV about the upcoming bond issue for Fire and Police buildings.
- 11-25: Chief Sims met with Smith Two-Way.
- 11-28 thru 11-29: City observed Thanksgiving Holiday.



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Fires & Mutual Aid:

- 11-2: Off-road vehicle or heavy equipment fire. Includes dirt bikes, specialty off-road vehicles, earth moving equipment (bulldozers), and farm equipment.
- 11-5: Mutual aid given to Pea Ridge, at 203 North Curtis Ave. Patient transported to NW Medical Center, Bentonville, AR.
- 11-7: Mutual aid given at 162 Little Missouri Rd, Pineville, MO. Patient refused transport. 10-9: Construction or demolition landfill fire at Ruthwell Dr., Bella Vista, AR.
- 11-8: Mutual aid given at Hwy 59 and Main St., Noel, Mo. Swift water rescue, false alarm, no patient found.

- 11-29: Mutual aid given at 149 Mile Marker 6.6, Pineville, AR for MVA. Patient taken to Mercy, Rogers.
