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Fires & Mutual Aid:

- 2-1: Forest, woods, or wildland fire. Includes fires involving vegetative fuels, other than prescribed fire (632), that occur in an area in which development is essentially nonexistent, except for roads, railroads, power lines, and the like at Tiverton/Greta, Bella Vista, AR.
- 2-3: Grass fire. Includes fire confined to area characterized by grass ground cover, with little or no involvement at 27 Hoyer Ln., Bella Vista, AR.
- 2-5: Chimney or flue fire, confined to chimney or flue (Fire originating in in and confined to a chimney or flue. Excludes fires that extend beyond the chimney (111 or 112)). Location: 9 Stokesay Ln., Bella Vista, AR.
- 2-8: Cooking fire, confined to container (fire involving the contents of a cooking vessel without fire extensions beyond the vessel) at 1 Stroud Circle, Bella Vista, AR.
- 2-9: Forest, woods, or wildland fire. Includes fires involving vegetative fuels, other than prescribed fire (632), that occur in an area in which development is essentially nonexistent, except for roads, railroads, power lines, and the like at 3 Boxford Dr., Bella Vista, AR.
