- 1-26: Mutual aid given at 145 North Curtis Ave. Pea Ridge, AR. Patient transported to Mercy Rogers Hospital.
- 1-27: Building fire (Building fire. Excludes confined fires (113-118)) at 7 Cawston Dr., Bella Vista, AR.
- 1-29: Cooking fire, confined to container (fire involving the contents of a cooking vessel without fire extension beyond the vessel) at Brookfield Assisted Living, 3 Highland Crossing Dr., Bella Vista, AR.
