Station 1 called for coverage 9 times in the month of November, meaning that there were too few or no personnel to cover the main fire station or the city.



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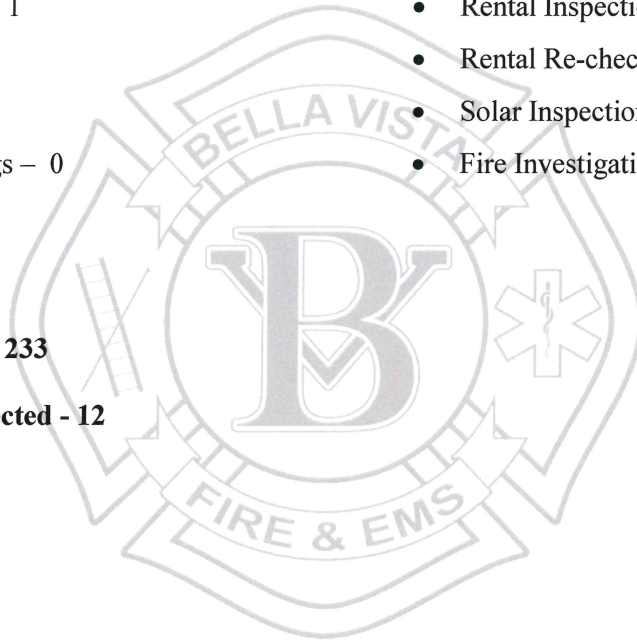
