## Station Coverage:

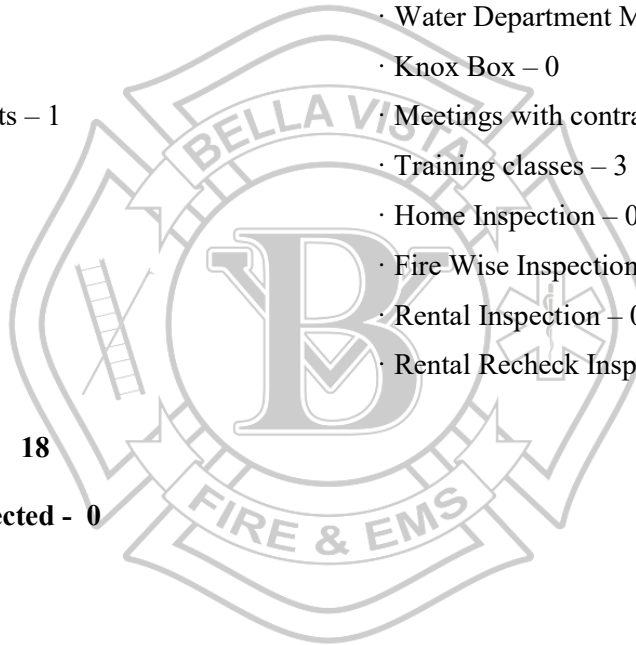
**Station 1 called for coverage 15 times in the month of May, meaning that there were too few or no personnel to cover the main fire station or the city.**
