Station Coverage:

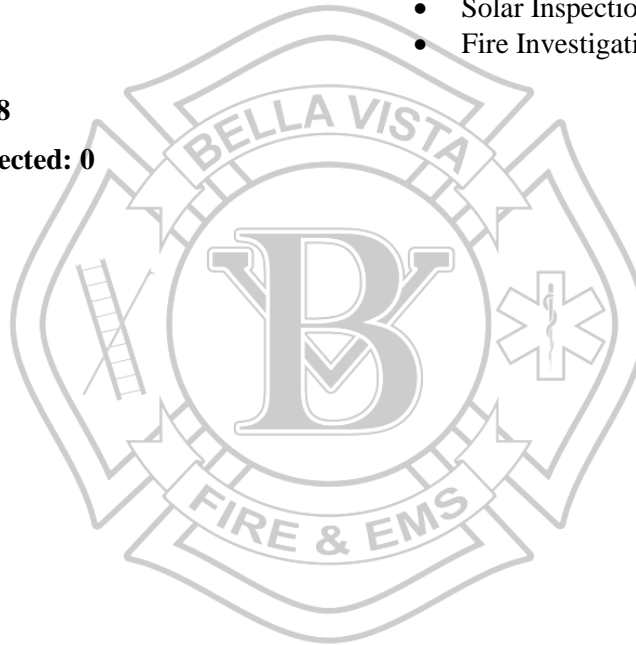
Station 1 called for coverage **8 times** in the month of July, meaning that **there were too few or no personnel to cover the main fire station or the city.**
