Station Coverage:

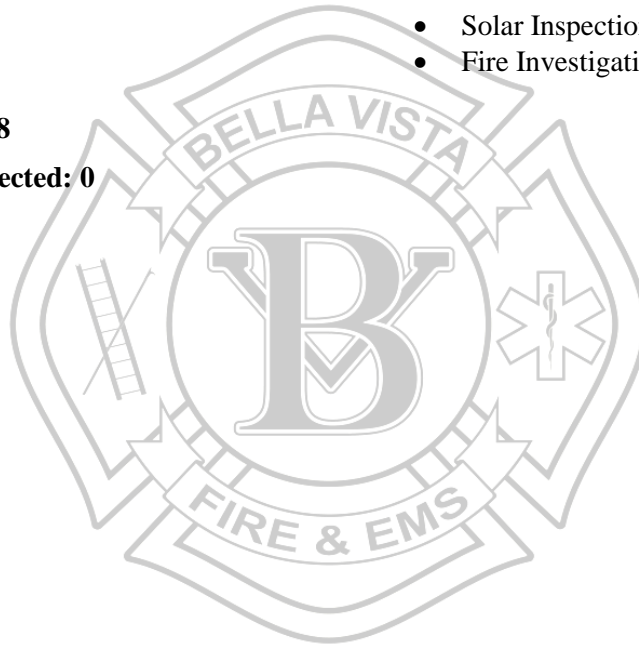
Station 1 called for coverage **14 times** in the month of June, meaning that **there were too few or no personnel to cover the main fire station or the city.**
