A Special Meeting is scheduled for Monday, September 18, 2023 at 6:30 p.m. in the Village Council Chambers located at 18500 W. 13 Mile Road, Beverly Hills MI 48025 to interview the applicants and make the appointment to the Council.

Procedurally, after the Council hears from all applicants present, the Chair will open the floor for nominations. Nominations by a Council member do not require a second. Once all nominations are heard, the Chair will entertain a motion to close the nominations. The Chair shall then call for a roll call vote for the nominees in the order they were received. The first candidate to receive a majority vote (4), will be appointed to the Village Council to fill the vacancy for a term ending November 2024.
