## HISTORIC MARKER FOR CIVILIAN CONSERVATION CORPS (C.C.C.) CAMPSITE IN WALTON APPROVED

The BCHS Board of Directors agreed at their April meeting to propose another historic marker commemorating the C.C.C. camp that existed in Walton during the 1930s. This camp was located at the end of Alta Vista Drive where the Walton Middle School is currently situated.



The BCHS members present at the May 19th meeting voted to proceed with the application and expenditure for this Kentucky Historical Marker. The cost will be \$2,500 which will come out of our Archival Fund.

The **mission** of the Boone County Historical Society is to develop awareness and promote appreciation of the history of Boone County, Kentucky.

The Boone County Historical Society provides program meetings at 7pm on the third Thursday evenings of January, March, May, July, September and November.

The Society hosts a number of exhibits at the BCHS Museum (see page 3) each year.
