



Boone County Historic Preservation Review Board

Requirements: Boone County Resident preferred but not required

Length of Term: 2 or 3 years

Description of Board: Seven member volunteer board whose mission is: "To lead and educate Boone County government and its citizens in the preservation and protection of Boone County's prehistoric and historic resources."

Function: Oversees historic preservation policy in the county. Duties include: enforcement of the Boone County Cemetery Preservation Plan; management of the Old Burlington Cemetery; ongoing survey and documentation of historic and prehistoric resources in Boone County; technical assistance to owners of historic properties; heritage education to both children and adults; historic preservation advocacy; administer annual Federal Survey & Planning (i.e., CLG) Grants; review nominations to the National Register of Historic Places for Boone County properties.

Meetings: Second Thursday of every month at 4 p.m. Regular meetings are usually held in the Ferguson Center, Historic Boone County Courthouse in Burlington and typically last one hour. The January meeting is usually held elsewhere and is a longer retreat format with enough time to plan for the upcoming year.
