



Parking Violations/ 911 Fee Hearing Board

Requirements: Each member of the Board shall have resided within the boundaries of Boone County for a period of at least one year prior to the date of the member's appointment and shall reside there throughout the term of office

Length of Term: 3 Years

Description of Board: Consists of 5 members all appointed by the Boone County Fiscal Court.

Function: The Board shall have jurisdiction to hear appeals of violations of those county ordinances regarding parking violations occurring within the county, City of Union, and the City of Walton which specifically provide for civil enforcement. The Board shall have the authority to consider and resolve any claims of incorrect determination of occupied individual residential units or individual commercial units for status for purpose of assessment of the annual 911 dwelling unit service fee as defined in Boone County, Kentucky, Code of Ordinances § 37.36.

Meetings: Quarterly or as needed
