

**EXECUTIVE ORDER 2020 – EO No. 6 (COV19)**

**AN ORDER AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR AND COUNTY TREASURER TO PROCESS AND EXECUTE ANY AND ALL DISBURSEMENTS FOR VALID INVOICES/CLAIMS AGAINST THE COUNTY ON A WEEKLY BASIS FOR THE COUNTY OF BOONE, KENTUCKY PURSUANT TO AN EMERGENCY DECLARATION ISSUED ON MARCH 13, 2020**

**WHEREAS**, our country and county is responding to the public health threat posed by the Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) and Emergency Declarations have been issued by the President and Governor; and

**WHEREAS**, this office has previously issued an Emergency Declaration pursuant to KRS 39A.100 (2) and 45A.380 (1) (7) on March 13, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, the county's emergency declaration is designed to render disaster assistance to those in need of such assistance, in this instance, retail businesses and other companies whose operations have been adversely impacted by the COVID-19 virus, and

**WHEREAS**, expedited payment of all outstanding invoices for goods and/or services, during the term of the emergency declaration, shall be in full compliance with the county's established procurement guideline or in direct response to the declared emergency and approved after affirmation of the receipt of materials, supplies or services rendered from the vendor.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Gary W. Moore, County Judge/Executive, do hereby authorize and direct the County Administrator and County Treasurer to proceed with weekly payment and processing of invoices. I further direct the County Treasurer to present all such payments/claims in report form for approval by the Fiscal Court, subsequent to the lifting of the Emergency Declaration.
