

**ORDINANCE NO. 2022-13**

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT, KENTUCKY, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2016-12, ENACTED ON JULY 5, 2016, AND BY ORDINANCE NO. 2019-11 ENACTED ON MAY 14, 2019 UPDATING THE LIST OF STREETS OWNED AND MAINTAINED BY BOONE COUNTY, ESTABLISHING THE SPEED LIMIT UPON SUCH STREETS AND ROADS, AND UPDATING DESIGNATED TRUCK ROUTES.**

**WHEREAS**, the Boone County Fiscal Court previously enacted Ordinance No. 2016-12 to establish speed limits upon County roads within the County; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to periodically add newly constructed County roads to a Master Schedule of designated speed limits; and

**WHEREAS**, the Boone County Fiscal Court deems it necessary to amend Ordinance 2016-12 to preserve the health, safety, welfare and convenience of the citizens of Boone County, pursuant to Fiscal Court's authority under KRS 67.083 and KRS 189.390.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT, OF COUNTY OF BOONE, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY:**

**Section One**

The Boone County Fiscal Court hereby amends Ordinance 2016-12 adopted on July 5, 2016 by adding the following streets to the County's Master Speed Limit Schedule as outlined in Exhibit "1" which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

**Section Two**

The County Engineer of Public Works or his designee is hereby authorized to recommend speed limits upon County roads not included in Attachment "1" herein. Said recommended speed limits from the County Engineer of Public Works shall be submitted periodically to the Boone County Fiscal Court for approval.

The County Engineer of Public Works or his designee is hereby directed to erect speed limit signs in compliance with state statutes and regulations upon County roads that comply with Attachment "1" of this Ordinance.

**Section Three**

Any person who violates the provisions of the Ordinance shall be subject to the penalties prescribed under KRS 189.390 and KRS 189.394.

**Section Four**


If any section or part of any section or any provision of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid by a Court of appropriate jurisdiction, for any reason, such declaration shall not invalidate, or adversely affect, the remainder of this Ordinance. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of said conflict.

This Ordinance shall be in effect and in full force from and after its passage, publication and recording, according to law.
