

ORDINANCE 2022 - 20

Amendment # 1

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT, KENTUCKY, AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2023 ALL FUNDS BUDGET ENACTED BY ORDINANCE NO. 2022-11, ADOPTED ON JUNE 28, 2022.

Whereas the County of Boone has realized unbudgeted receipts in the newly established County Clerk Permanent Storage Fund and requires re-appropriations and/or technical adjustments in the budgets of the General Fund, Capital Improvement Fund and Mental Health/Intellectual Disability/Senior Citizens Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF COUNTY OF BOONE, COMMONWEALTH KENTUCKY:

Section One

The budget for fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 is amended to:

A. Increase / Decrease the following revenue accounts of the County Clerk Permanent Storage Fund and the General Fund:

Table with 4 columns: Account, Description, Approved Budget, Amended Budget. Rows include 4731-Miscellaneous Revenues, 4711-Rentals & Leases, 4910-Cash Transfer In, and Grand Total All Funds.

B. Increase / Decrease the following expenditure accounts of the County Clerk Permanent Storage Fund, the Capital Improvement Fund, the Mental Health/Intellectual Disability/Senior Citizens Fund and the General Fund:

Table with 4 columns: Account, Description, Approved Budget, Amended Budget. Rows include 540-County Clerk Permanent Storage, 741-Other Capital Outlay, 999-Reserve Balance, 301-Accounting Services, 178-Overtime Pay, and Grand Total All Funds.

Section Two

This budget Ordinance amendment was read for the first time, in open session, at a regularly scheduled Fiscal Court meeting on Tuesday, August 9, 2022. Second reading of the Ordinance is scheduled for final action at the Tuesday, August 23, 2022 Fiscal Court meeting.


This Ordinance shall be in effect and in full force from and after its passage, publication, and recording, according to law.
