The nomination period for these offices begins on Monday, February 14, 2022 and closes on Friday, March 11, 2022 at 5:00 p.m.

If nomination papers for an incumbent are not filed by 5:00 p.m. on March 11, 2022, the nomination period shall be extended until Wednesday, March 16, 2022 at 5:00 p.m., for persons other than the incumbent.

If no one or only one person is nominated for an elective office, appointment to the elective office may be made as prescribed by \$10229, Elections Code of the State of California.

KEEPING STORM DRAINS CLEAN



During these rainy days, it is important to consider what goes down our stormdrains. Stormdrains are responsible for carrying all stormwater (rain) to a local body of water. Consider the following tips to do your part to ensure only clean rainwater enters the stormdrain system:

- Clean up oil spills and fluid leaks from your car when parked in your driveway. Use cat litter to absorb oil and be sure to sweep up the litter once it absorbs the oil and dispose of it in the trash;
- Take your car to the car wash instead of washing it in the driveway, so water doesn't run into the stormdrain; and,
- Pick up pet waste and dispose of it in a trash can.
