For example, in the event of an emergency, the City can quickly let you know what to do or where to go for services. Only authorized City officials are allowed to send messages. Let's Keep Bradbury Beautiful!



KEEPING STORM DRAINS CLEAN



During these rainy days, it is important to consider what goes down our stormdrains. Stormdrains are responsible for carrying all stormwater (rain) to a local body of water. Consider the following tips to do your part to ensure only clean rainwater enters the stormdrain system:

- Clean up oil spills and fluid leaks from your car when parked in your driveway. Use cat litter to absorb oil and be sure to sweep up the litter once it absorbs the oil and dispose of it in the trash;
- Take your car to the car wash instead of washing it in the driveway, so water doesn't run into the stormdrain; and.
- Pick up pet waste and dispose of it in a trash can.

Valentines Day DIY Chocolate Fondue

Recipe:

1 pound of premium semisweet or bittersweet chocolate, well chopped 1 1/2 cups of organic heavy cream
