

RESOLUTION FOR ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS

Bremer County Resolution No. 22-54

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors is empowered under authority of the Iowa Code Sections 321.255 and 321.285, to determine upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation, that the speed limit of any secondary road is greater than is reasonable and proper under the conditions existing, and may determine and declare a reasonable and proper speed limit, and

WHEREAS, such an investigation has been requested by the Bremer County Engineer and has been completed by the Iowa Department of Transportation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF Bremer County that the speed limit be established and appropriate signs be erected at the location described as follows:

45 MPH on Hilton Avenue beginning at a point 1,300 feet east and 100 feet north of the NW corner of Section 20-T91N-R13W to a point 600 feet north and 1,920 feet east of the SW corner of Section 20-T91N-R13W in Jackson Township.
