

DRAINAGE MINUTES

December 19, 2022

The Bremer County Board of Supervisors as Drainage District Trustees in Bremer County, IA, met in session on Monday, December 19, 2022 in the Courthouse, Waverly, Iowa, at 11:30 a.m. Hildebrandt, Kammeyer, Neil present. Unless otherwise noted, all actions were approved unanimously.

Meeting was called to order by Chairman Hildebrandt. Kammeyer moved/Neil second to approve the agenda. Neil moved/Kammeyer second to approve the 12/12/22 minutes.

Kammeyer moved/Neil second to request Drainage Engineer Collin Klingbeil, P.E., Jacobson-Westergard & Associates Inc, perform an evaluation of the classifications in all Bremer County Drainage Districts to determine if they are equitable and if reclassification is necessary.

Board reviewed a draft Ordinance and Application for Easement for construction of a pipeline, electric transmission line, communication line, underground service line, or other similar installations over, across, or beneath county drainage district infrastructure with Drainage Engineer Collin Klingbeil, P.E., Jacobson-Westergard & Associates Inc., by phone. Board requested Klingbeil evaluate the Drainage District Ordinance in comparison to the Zoning Ordinance in progress to ensure they are in sync. The Drainage District Ordinance will also be sent to Drainage Attorney Gabor for legal review.
