

DRAINAGE MINUTES

January 6, 2020

The Bremer County Board of Supervisors as Trustees of Drainage Districts #1 and #6 in Bremer County, IA, met in session on Monday, January 6, 2020 in the Courthouse, Waverly, Iowa, at 2:00 p.m. Neil, Kammeyer, Hildebrandt present. Unless otherwise noted, all actions were approved unanimously.

Meeting was called to order by Chairman Neil, Kammeyer moved/Hildebrandt second to approve the agenda. Landon Moore, County Engineer, Jennifer Bremner, Auditor's Office Clerk, Sue Shonka, present.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Drainage Dist #1

Jim Figanbaum, landowner and Sam Smith, Smith Excavating, Inc. explained work that was done after Figanbaum purchased the property in December 1998, issues that have continued and drainage work that was recently completed. An underground main was installed to relieve Figanbaum's farm of the excessive water across his farm due to the county main being too small. Smith assessed the watershed and existing tile and designed drainage to accommodate approximately 430 acres of drainage that comes through Figanbaum's and neighboring Westendorf's. David Kirchhoff, landowner, present, stated a desire to withdraw or be exempt from the Drainage District.

Drainage Dist #6

Landon Moore, County Engineer, reported an issue received from Terry Schneider. Sam Smith, Smith Excavating, present, is working with Schneider on the issue. It appears to not be broken, but rather in need of improvement to accommodate more water. A work order form, once designed, will be sent to Smith/Schneider to complete and return.

Hildebrandt moved/Kammeyer second to adjourn at 3:29 p.m.
