

October 7, 2019

The Bremer County Board of Supervisors as Trustees of Drainage Districts in Bremer County, met in session on Monday, October 7, 2019 in the Courthouse, Waverly, Iowa, at 9:00 a.m. Neil, Kammeyer, Hildebrandt present. Unless otherwise noted, all actions were approved unanimously.

Meeting was called to order. Hildebrandt moved/ Kammeyer second to approve the agenda. Kassandra Johansen, Finance Director, Landon Moore, County Engineer, Sue Shonka, Treasurer, Jennifer Bremner, Auditor's Office Clerk, present.

Kammeyer moved/Hildebrandt second to approve the 9/30/19 minutes.

Auditor's Office gave an update on the following:

- Clarification in regard to who assumes the role of chairperson of the Trustees of Drainage Districts
- Reported the number of landowners in Drainage District #16, which is in need of repair
- Presented a list of Drainage Engineers provided by IDDA (Iowa Drainage District Association)

Hildebrandt suggested an Engineer may not be needed, that with the original records the drainage levy could be proportioned effectively without the added cost of an Engineer. Neil shared concern that the acres may be benefited differently today than they were in the past. Bremner stated the records are aged enough and landscape has changed and land has been divided.

Trustees directed a letter be drafted to landowners in Drainage District #16 notifying them of course of action, potential solution and an invitation to participate in a meeting with the Trustees. Letter will be sent after review by the County Attorney.

No action taken on selection of a Drainage Engineer.

Hildebrandt moved/Kammeyer second to adjourn at 9:33 a.m.
