Applicants who are denied for placement of asphalt emulsion may apply any other form of approved dust control after submitting a dust control permit to the Bremer County Highway Department.

### **Asphalt Emulsion Agreement**

**CONSTRUCTION:** The applicant or contractor applying asphalt emulsions shall notify the County Engineer's Office 10 working days in advance, so that the roadway may be properly prepared prior to application. The applicant or contractor are responsible for all traffic control and signs required during construction.

**GENERAL MAINTENANCE:** Applicant agrees to maintain the treated area in a manner which maintains the safety of roadway traffic and maintains a surface free from defects. Defects include, but are not limited to, potholes, ruts and rough surfaces that would cause an unsafe surface for vehicular traffic. By signing this agreement, applicant assumes responsibility and liability for insufficient or improper maintenance.

**WINTER MAINTENANCE:** In order to provide a safe roadway for all users, Bremer County maintains the right to use snow removal methods which may include the use of salt or heavy equipment. Any damage which occurs to the surface as a result of snow removal activities shall be repaired by the applicant.

**IMPROPER MAINTENANCE:** Judgement of a defective or unsafe surface shall be at the sole discretion of the County Engineer or his authorized representative. Bremer County shall notify the applicant in writing upon a finding of a defective or unsafe surface. Applicant shall have 30 days from the date on the letter to repair the surface, or submit a written plan to the Bremer County Highway Department of their intended method of repair and timeframe to complete. Failure to repair or provide a written plan shall result in removal, as outlined below. Bremer County may request changes to or submittal of a new written plan if a submitted plan is deemed insufficient.

**REMOVAL:** Bremer County shall submit a written notice to the applicant of their intent to remove the surface. Said notice shall include a date after which Bremer County may remove the surface. The date shall be no less than 10 days from the date of the letter. Bremer County may remove the surface and return the road to gravel at any time after the date in the notice and may use its own crews or hire a 3<sup>rd</sup> party contractor to perform the work. **Applicant agrees to pay all costs associated with removal of the surface.** Bremer County shall submit an invoice for said costs after removal is completed and may place reasonable time constraints on payment of the invoice. Applicants who have a surface removed shall be ineligible for future applications for a period of time deemed appropriate by Bremer County.
