Explanation of increases in the budget:

The increase in the general services budget is due to increases in expenses for liability insurance, wages and benefits and an increase in the cost of goods and services. The increase in the rural services budget is due to the need to continue to provide adequate funding to our secondary roads department to ensure roads and bridges are maintained.
