

City of Camarillo Weekly Refuse & Recycling Services

he City of Camarillo is pleased to offer our customers multiple refuse service levels, with corresponding volumebased charges. Curbside recycling is an integral part of each service level. Yard waste recycling is provided with both Standard and High Volume Service. Please select a service option based on your disposal habits.

All customers should place refuse in green barrels, curbside recyclables in blue barrels and yard debris and wood waste in tan barrels (except for minimum service customers). All barrels are collected weekly. Refuse placed outside the green barrel or yard waste outside of the tan barrel will NOT be picked up! Recyclables that don't fit in the blue barrel will be picked up free of charge by calling E.J. Harrison & Sons at (805) 647-1414 prior to a recycling day. On the City's website, you may search the collection schedule for your neighborhood using an interactive map.

STANDARD SERVICE - \$33.77 per month

Most Camarillo residents subscribe to this service option.

- 96-gallon, green refuse barrel, and
- 96-gallon, tan yard debris barrel, and
- 96-gallon, blue recycling barrel.

Upon request, a smaller 64- or 32-gallon refuse barrel will be provided for the same monthly rate.




HIGH VOLUME SERVICE - \$42.38 per month

For customers with large amounts of refuse or yard debris. Two barrel configurations are offered.

- Two green refuse barrels—one 96-gallon and one 64-gallon (160 gallons), and
- One 96-gallon, tan yard debris barrel, and
- 96-gallon, blue recycling barrel.

- One 96-gallon, green refuse barrel, and
- Two 96-gallon, tan yard debris barrels (192 gallons), and
- 96-gallon, blue recycling barrel.





MINIMUM SERVICE - \$29.38 per month

Customers with small amounts of refuse and yard debris.

- 32-gallon, green refuse barrel, and
- 96-gallon, *blue* recycling barrel.
- Yard debris barrel NOT supplied.

All refuse, including yard debris, must fit inside the



Weekly refuse

Holidays

Refuse, curbside recycling and yard debris will not be collected on the following holidays:

- New Year's Day
- Memorial Day
- Independence Day
- · Labor Day
- Thanksgiving Day
- Christmas Day

Pick up will be one day late following a holiday that occurs during the week, with Friday collections made on Saturday. If the holiday falls on a weekend, refuse will be picked up on the regularly scheduled day.

Collection Services

All three container are emptied weekly. Trucks may arrive any time between 7 A.M. and 5 P.M. on collection day. Barrels must be at the curb by 6:30 A.M. and removed from public view by 12 midnight on collection day or be subject to a \$50 fine. Barrels must weigh less than 100 pounds or a service fee will be charged. Refuse and yard debris must fit inside the appropriate barrel or display an "extra service" tag. To report a missed collection call E.J. Harrison at (805) 647-1414.

For occasional extra refuse, service tags are available for purchase at City Hall, 601 Carmen Drive. Each \$5 tag may be used to discard an extra bag of refuse. Call (805) 388-5325 for more information.

Collection Services-Cont.

Subscription Level Adjustments

Service levels may be adjusted one time in a 12 month period FREE of charge. Additional changes will incur a \$25 charge.

Bulky Item Collection Program

E.J. Harrison & Sons will collect two bulky items per calendar year—free of charge—(not including special disposal fees). Accepted items include mattresses, dishwashers, water heaters, furniture, etc., and tree stumps that weigh less than 50 pounds.

Harrison will bill customers separately for freon removal (refrigerators, freezers, window air conditioners), Cathode Ray Tube (CRT) handling (computer monitors and televisions) and other items that require special handling such as tires. Call (805) 647-1414 to arrange for this service.

Vacancy Exemption

If refuse has not been generated for the previous 60 days, and the property will continue to be vacant for the foreseeable future, a resident may apply for a vacancy exemption. If a vacancy exemption is approved a \$25 fee will be assessed when barrels are removed. For more information, call Customer Service at 388-5325.

Special Services

Refuse Bin Rental

3- and 4-cubic yard refuse bins and large roll-off containers may be rented for those big clean-up projects. Call E.J. Harrison at (805) 647-1414 to arrange for bin rental. Harrison will bill you directly for these services.

Household Hazardous Waste Program

Household hazardous wastes (HHW) like paint, solvents, pesticides, pool chemicals, household cleaners, batteries, fluorescent light tubes, etc., must NOT be discarded in refuse or recycling barrels. The city's HHW drop-off center is open the second consecutive Friday and Saturday of each month. Please call 987-0717 to schedule an appointment or online at www.cityofcamarillo.org.

Used motor oil and oil filters may be recycled at State-certified oil recycling centers. Call 1-800-CLEANUP for locations.

Electronic Waste Recycling Program

Televisions and monitors must NOT be discarded in landfills because they may contain toxic materials. Recycle electronic wastes, free of charge at Gold Coast Recycling, 5275 Colt Street, Ventura, (805) 642-9236. Proof of residency is required. For other locations, visit www.cityofcamarillo.org.



WEEKLY RESIDENTIAL CURBSIDE RECYCLING PROGRAM

Recycle the following materials in the **blue** recycling barrel. Collection is bi-weekly. Recyclables that don't fit in the blue barrel will be picked up free of charge by calling E.J. Harrison & Sons at 647-1414 prior to a recycling day. Put extras in cans, bags or boxes next to the blue barrel for collection.

Aluminum and Metal Containers



All aluminum, tin and steel beverage, and food cans. All aluminum foil.

Plastics (1 through 7)



Plastics 1-7 and yogurt containers are also recyclable.





Glass Containers



All colors of jars & beverage containers. (Lids & labels okay.)

Do NOT put ceramics, glassware, mirrors, window glass, food waste, and diapers in your blue barrel.

Do *NOT* put Styrofoam™, plastic film, straws, bubble wrap, food soiled paper, hoses, diapers shrink wrap, needles, shredded paper, and plastic bags in your blue barrel.

Paper & Cardboard



Newspapers, magazines, catalogs, "junk" mail & envelopes, paper bags, cardboard (flattened, cut to 4' by 4'), phone books, paper board such as cereal-type boxes, egg cartons, juice boxes, and milk cartons.

Do NOT put used paper towels, tissue, clothing rags, and soiled pizza boxes in your blue barrel.

WEEKLY YARD & WOOD WASTE COLLECTION PROGRAM

Yard debris and wood wastes are collected every week on your regular trash day. All yard waste must fit inside the tan barrel. To maximize efficiency, please wait until the barrel is full before placing it out for collection.

Acceptable Materials

- Grass
- Leaves, Pine Needles
- Yard Trimmings
- **Small Branches** (4' long by 4" diameter)
- No Treated Wood, Scrap Lumber
- Christmas Trees, Shrubs, Plants





Unacceptable Materials

- **PLASTIC BAGS**
- Stumps, Yucca, Palm, Iceplant
- Animal Waste/Manure
- Sod, Dirt, Rocks, Flower Pots
- Trash, plastic, glass, metal, diapers
- Styrofoam, hoses, shrink wrap, treated wood



Place these materials in a green refuse barrel for disposal. Fully-loaded barrels must weigh less than 100 pounds.
