



## **SPRING CLEAN-UP & RECYCLING EVENT APRIL 13th, 8AM-2PM**

### **Entry Fees for Household Waste Drop-off at entry gate at 4<sup>th</sup> & Colorado:**

Proof of Town of Carbondale residency required for gate/recycling fees

Town of Carbondale (resident)	\$10	Non-resident	\$30
Load with trailer (resident)	\$20	Non-resident	\$60

Mattress recycling (\$20/mattress paid at entry gate)

Refrigerator/freezer with freon - \$40 per unit (paid at entry gate)

Air conditioning unit - \$50/unit (paid at entry gate)

### **Mountain Waste:**

- General household trash (furniture/fencing, etc.)
- Metal recycling
- Wood recycling
- Mattress recycling (\$20 per mattress)
- Textile recycling (must be in bags for recycling)
- **All customers will be responsible for charges related to refrigerators and other freon items.**

Refrigerator/freezer with freon - \$40 per unit

Air conditioning unit - \$50/unit

❖ **Out-of-Town resident drop-off items for the vendors listed below are NOT FREE and applicable fees will be charged.**

### **Blue Star Recyclers:**

- **ELECTRONIC WASTE:** Computers, hard drives, cell phones.
- **TV's:** Flat screen, CRT display and projector tv's, cords and power supplies
- Cameras, recording equipment, radios, routers, hubs, tablets, keyboards, mice, copiers, printers, microwave, DVR/DVD/CD players (\$.65/lb)
- **MEDIA:** CD/DVD/tapes (\$3/lb)
- **ALKALINE BATTERIES & NON-RECHARGABLE ONLY** (AA, AAA, C, D, 9V)  
**NO other battery types are accepted due to transportation and fire issues.**
- **LIGHT BULBS:** Fluorescent tubes (.25/ft), Incandescent, CFL, U-tubes, Halogen (.75/ea),  
LED straight tubes (\$4.50 ea), HID and LED bulbs (\$2.50 ea), UV lights (\$5/ea)

### **JLM Tires:**

- No charge for Town residents for the first 100 tires, up to 18" w/o rims.
- Limit of 8 free tires per customer.
- A fee of \$10 per tire will be paid by all customers after the Town budget limit has been reached.

### **ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED:**

- **Hazard waste**, i.e., oil, paint, cleaning fluids/canisters, car liquids, propane bottles
- **NO prescription drug drop-off at this event but it is scheduled for April 27 from 10-2p at the Carbondale Police Dept.**
- **Yard waste and branches will NOT be accepted at this event.**  
Yard waste and branches 2" or less in diameter will be accepted at the seasonal Yard Waste event that begins on April 20, 2024, and every-other weekend through September. This event is located at 4<sup>th</sup> & Colorado, 9a-noon. Town residents only.
- Crews will alternate lunches between noon and 1p. Unloading may take additional time during this timeframe. Please plan accordingly.
- Check, cash, debit/credit card accepted.
