



Our Legacy was founded in 1887...

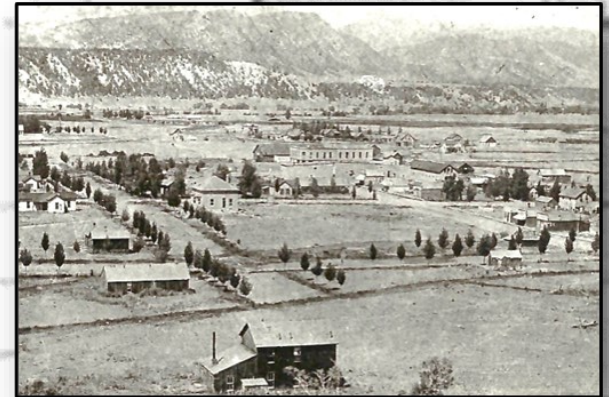

Landmark Considerations

Home/building must be at least 50 years old and either listed in one of the Town Surveys or approved by the CHPC based upon its significance according to architectural, social, geographical/environmental, or archaeological criteria.
