

HOMEOWNER AGREEMENT FOR GENERAL/SUB-CONTRACTOR

- Electrical contractors are licensed by the State and pull electrical permits through the State.
- Plumbing contractors are licensed by the State for both a State Contractor and Master Plumber license.
- Each license type has a defined set of competence criteria that contractors must meet to achieve and maintain, both with the State and/or the Town of Carbondale.
- General, mechanical, plumbing, roofing and solar contractors are required to be licensed with the Town of Carbondale.
- The contractor license requirements are on the contractor license application on our website here, which include proof of insurances;

- Using an unlicensed or uninsured contractor may lead to unintended consequences or even civil liabilities.
- Any homeowner who undertakes contracting work for a new home or a new addition, within
 the scope of the building codes, as adopted in Chapter 18 of this Code, must have taken and
 passed a Town Homeowner BEST test.
- A homeowner/builder, any person constructing a home for his or her own residence or
 effecting remodels or additions to his or her own home, may undertake all work with the
 assistance of no more than two other people. A person who obtains more than one building
 permit to build a new home in any three-year period shall not be considered a
 homeowner/builder exempt from the licensing requirements.
