RULES

1. USE THIS FACILITY AT YOUR OWN RISK
2. HELMETS ARE HIGHLY RECOMMENDED, AS IS ALL OTHER SAFETY EQUIPMENT
3. INAPPROPRIATE LANGUAGE AND BEHAVIOR IS PROHIBITED
4. ADDING OR MODIFYING FEATURES IS PROHIBITED
5. NO ALCOHOL, TOBACCO, OR DRUGS
6. GLASS CONTAINERS ARE PROHIBITED
7. NO STICKERS OR GRAFFITI IN ANY FORM
8. NO DOGS OR OTHER ANIMALS ALLOWED IN PARK
9. PARK USE BY ORGANIZED GROUPS, CLASSES, OR TEAMS IS NOT ALLOWED WITHOUT A PERMIT ISSUED BY THE TOWN OF CARBONDALE
10. USE OF AERIAL UNMANNED DRONES MUST BE APPROVED BY THE TOWN OF CARBONDALE
