

#### Utilization:

- Sold out days increased by 17 over last year. Last September we had 9 sold out days, this September we had 22. Blocked sites for the bridge impacted overall revenue for August and September but year over year we were still ahead of 2016.
- The three blocked sites impacted revenue by approximately \$3000 for the year. The real activity is reflected in the utilization below. September was busier than last September. Overall, August was the only month that saw a lower utilization compared to last year.
- RV Sites total booked percentage for season 2017 = 79% Tent sites booked percentage for season 2017 = 37% With the overflow RV site being booked almost 40% of the time the switch from tent sites to RV sites will bring additional revenue and bring up the 21% usage of the group tent area.
