

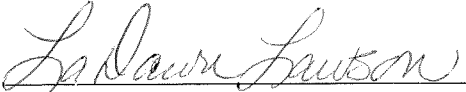
## PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE

- I. Call to Order and Roll Call:**
- a. The meeting was called to order at 7:05 p.m., by Chairperson Dan Ferguson.
  - b. Board Members Present: Dan Ferguson, Gaylene Ferguson, Ellen Meshefski, Rhonda Smith, Jon Gift, Tonya Roland, Danny Smith, Patty Pawelek, (Lorilee Munster absent).
  - c. Staff Members Present: Mr. William Kohbarger (City Manager).
  - d. Citizens Present: Donnetta Skinner, Rose Gift, Anna Dean, Tim Grey, Tim Sirotek (Council Liaison).
- II. Planning for 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Spook Walk and All Matters Related Thereto. (Action Item).**
1. Ellen Meshefski stated she got the bands, there's only 104. They were given to them by the race track. Everything is going good. Some of them will be going out at 3:00 p.m., to start putting up stakes on Friday.
  2. Chairperson Dan Ferguson stated the parking area is ready, and they have a walk trail from the parking area that goes through the brush and through the fence.
  3. Ellen Meshefski stated they have light plants that will light the parking area. She has one (1) cubby that isn't filled. There are a few places out there that doesn't have anything. She's had five (5) or six (6) kids that want to be spooks, they're not with any organization or anything, they just want to help out. The door will be ready. There's eleven (11) booths. Bands MUST be worn. The cost is a flat \$2.00 each. The people that pay get stamped, the bands are only for the workers. If anybody has a couple sheets of plywood, they need it. They need extra generators. Lonny Brown will help fill generators. Lorilee Munster ordered two (2) cases of corn. The booths are all okay, the Senior Center needs baked foods.
  4. Chairperson Dan Ferguson asked Mr. William Kohbarger if there was is some way that they can generate money through the Spook Walk to go directly back to the Chinese Gardens for improvements and stuff? If they put out something for donations and marked it for the Chinese Gardens, will that money be ear marked and targeted just for the Chinese Gardens?
  5. Mr. William Kohbarger confirmed yes. Bring it in and give it to LaDawn Lawson and they will create a line item in the budget and stick it in there.
  6. Ellen Meshefski stated Mr. Feasel suggested charging every booth \$5.00, which will go back into renovating or fixing up the Chinese Gardens. Her suggestion is to put a bucket up at each booth stating "Donations needed for up keep or whatever for the Chinese Gardens".
  7. Rose Gift suggested when dividing the shares at the end of the Spook Walk to include the Chinese Gardens.

**8. Motion made by Tonya Roland to put in a Fifteenth (15) Booth just for the Chinese Gardens. Seconded by Gaylene Ferguson. Motion carried.**

9. Ellen Meshefski suggested giving fog machines as a prize for the best booth and cubby.

**III. Review and Possible Approval of Proceeding with the Building of a Equestrian Park, Golf Course, or Swimming Pool. (Action Item).**

1. Chairperson Dan Ferguson stated Cliff Eklund, Mr. Kohbarger and himself had a meeting about a month or so ago, and they decided to take on two (2). They decided on the Equestrian Park and the Driving Range, but they haven't voted on it as a committee, that's what they thought they could handle. As far as the swimming pool they still need more information on it before they can proceed. They need to vote on the two (2) they've decided on and discuss it.
2. Anna Dean asked who's paying for this?
3. Chairperson Dan Ferguson stated all the money is coming from donations and advertising. Cliff Eklund, Lew Eklund, Jim Bailey, George Goddard, Donnetta Skinner and himself are on the Equestrian Park committee. What they are going to do is the committee's are going to get together, it's not going to be just a Parks & Rec. Board thing, the committee's are actually doing it, but they would like the Parks & Rec. to kind of be the spear head of the things. They will both be under the Parks & Rec. Board.
4. Donnetta Skinner stated they already have a lady committed to come in and give riding lessons, another lady to teach barrel racing. It's going to really go once it's in.
5. Rhonda Smith stated she thinks the Driving Range is a good idea. It will be another attraction to the City to not only have things for children, but the adults too.
6. Chairperson Dan Ferguson stated they need to know whether the Parks & Rec. Board is going to sponsor these project and the two (2) committee's are taken care of. As far as the Equestrian Park, they already have all the materials to build it, the dirt work done, and the land. They have three (3) different outfits that want to use it, they want it for their home arena.
7. Mr. William Kohbarger explained the progress, so far, on the Driving Range.

**8. Motion made by Danny Smith the Parks & Rec. Board Approves the Building of the Equestrian Park and Driving Range. Seconded by Tonya Roland. Motion carried.**

Mr. William Kohbarger stated Don Cox, the one who runs the motor cross track, he's been wanting since last year to do a grand prix, which is a 10 mile loop. He met with Don Cox today and came up with somewhat an idea of starting down around the Chinese Gardens, going down through Willow, up Fir Street, down Hamilton, up 10<sup>th</sup>, back down to Fir Street, up and then right where Fir Street ends, go up Boothill, down Boothill, up the Foothill, back down the Foothills, back out underneath the overpass, all the way back to the track, and do a couple laps around the track. Don Cox is working on the other two (2) mile loop which will go all the way out to Eureka County and back. He's looking at doing this in

the first or second week of May. This will be a once a year annual event. This could bring up to 500 bikes. Huge Cities and small Cities do this, they block off streets where they do this. Carlin will have to block off the two (2) main streets, Bush and Hamilton, however, there are plenty of ways to get around Carlin, and this will be a twenty (20) mile, three (3) lap race. According to Don Cox he's helped set them up around this area, and after a few years they can be very successful. What he wants to know is if the Parks & Rec. Board wanted to further this idea. Mr. Kohbarger thinks it's a great thing, it's Economic Development and recreation, it's a win, win. It will be Don Cox's promotion, and he has backing. He asking the Parks & Rec. Board to put this on as an official action item, for them to sponsor, and then he will take it to the Council. He's already talked to Police Chief Bauer.

**Everybody agreed to bring this back as an action item on the next agenda.**

**IV. Review Scheduling Nick Gift Memorial Hoop Shoot. (Action Item)**

1. Chairperson Dan Ferguson stated the weekend that they usually schedule this to be is not available. They would like to reschedule and do it right after school is out, and do it in conjunction with Howard Wright and the camp that he does.
2. Tonya Roland asked if the Business Show is still going?
3. Chairperson Dan Ferguson stated he heard after last year's show was over, they didn't think they were going to do it again.
4. Rose Gift suggested having it in the summer so a lot of the kids returning home from college could participate in it.

**5. Motion made by Danny Smith to Table Scheduling Nick Gift Memorial Hoop Shoot until Next Meeting in November. Seconded by Gaylene Ferguson. Motion carried.**

**IV. Committee Member Reports. (Non-Action Item)**

1. Rhonda Smith stated since Palisades is not going to continue their annual lighting, she suggested putting some sort of a Christmas Village in the City Park this year.
2. Rose Gift stated Palisades is willing to donate all their toys to the City if the City wants to do something like this. Her brother even said he would be willing to play Santa.
3. Chairperson Dan Ferguson stated it was suggested to have it as a tribute to the Palisades Family. The first year, if they do it, make it a tribute to the Johnson Family & Palisades Lights. They need some people to spear head it. Next meeting they can bring it up as an action item, but it only gives them one (1) month to plan. So they need a consensus tonight, and a couple people that want to get on a committee to start planning, and have a full blown plan by next meeting. This will be placed on the agenda for the next meeting as an action item. Committee will consist of:

4. Chairperson Dan Ferguson asked for someone else from Parks & Rec to be on the Equestrian Park committee, and a couple for the Driving Range committee.

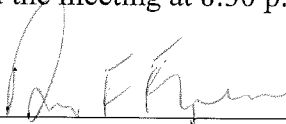

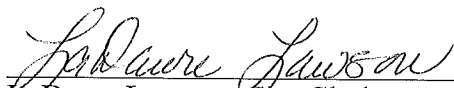
