TAX-All sales of food for immediate consumption and tangible personal property are subject to State Of Nevada sales tax. “Carlin Art in the Park” will supply the 2-day license for this event and we will supply Sales Tax forms as required by the State of Nevada. Any other permits/licenses are the responsibility of the individual vendor. Payments must be made directly to the Nevada Department of Taxation, by each vendor. A list of all vendors will be submitted to the Nevada Department of Taxation as per their request.

Health Inspections- All vendors selling ready to eat food will be required to obtain a permit from the State of Nevada Health Division. All Vendors selling ready-to-eat food and offering tattoo and piercing services, will be subject to inspection by the State of Nevada. Carlin Art in the Park will provide information about pertinent regulations to you when your registration is complete.

Security-Carlin Art in the Park will provide security overnight, but we assume no responsibility for loss or damage to the property of exhibitors.

Pets are not allowed at Special Events in the City of Carlin so please make other arrangements for your pet.
