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New Business

Mr. Robbie McCraw: I would like to see us start showing on our time sheets, that the guys are using out in the field I would like to see their time broke out. Where they are at, maybe do like a list of materials that they use, on each thing that they use and to track the actual cost of what is going on. Maybe if they use any equipment the hours on the equipment before and after that way, we can track that. If you need something as a sample, I have a sample. I bet Tracy has something along that line too.

Mr. Tracy Moore: We do.

Mrs. Dana Phillips: Currently Shane, Scotty and John daily email what they did that day. That has whoever was helping them or assisting them. They do not always put the time, how long it takes them to do each item. We can certainly do something like that. But use a different sheet besides a time sheet to keep it clean, if that's what you would like.

Mr. Robbie McCraw: I think that would be the appropriate thing to do to keep a better track on what it is costing on items. I can send you something so you can see what will work the best.

Mrs. Dana Phillips: OK if you all will send that to me. We will get that started.

Project Up-Dates

Mrs. Dana Phillips: This week we had about three meters come in to be set. So even though our connection cost has gone up we are still setting several meters each week. I think you all saw the letter from Mount Rodgers Planning District Commission. We had a grant for the Cana well improvements. This ran out at the end of June this past year June 30th, 2019. We do not have all our grant funds expended. We were still waiting on the Lane Group for their estimate for what it would cost to get well #8 filtration system up and going. Basically, we were working on the wells. If we could get the wells up and running and updating them some and the filtration system up and running. Right now, we are not able to use #8 that much because it is silty. But we got the letter from Brian Reed and they will be pulling that money back because we did not complete it by June 30, 2019. Part of what was there was a \$100,000.00 match that went along with that. And we were not going to be able to get those funds from the county either. So, at this time we have spent \$28,000.00 in the grant and we must show for that amount. So, when we get the price back from the Lane Group, we will see what that looks like. I have no idea what it will be. I know that the building will have to be expanded in order to hold the filtration

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system. So, we will re-address that, at that time. We can go back and re-apply. But we would still have to have the match of the grant. So, when we get to the point that we have the bid in for the improvements we will see how you all feel about it and go from there. In the past they were able to set the money aside and go ahead and use the grant money in a different year but that as changed with the Governor. Do you have any questions? I won't go over the PSA general updates, but we did meet with, we are currently in a contract with a tank company. It is called Suez. Originally when we got into this agreement with them, they were Caldwell and the agreement is up in 2021. So, to refresh ourselves we had a meeting Scotty, John and myself and them they will be getting back to us at the tank at Lynnhaven that is the one that looks so bad on 221 and see if we can get that on this years contract for this year. What was wrong with that one and the reason they had not worked on it was there is a valve that has a problem underneath the tank. He is going to see if that is part of the contract and get back with us.

Mr. Tracy Moore: That valve don't even cut that tank off does it?

Mrs. Dana Phillips: It is broken. But he thought that he is the gentlemen that was originally with Caldwell, when we went into the contract with Caldwell. So, he was going to check and see if that would be part of the maintenance. So, we are hoping it will be and we can get that taken care of this year. As soon as we get that report back from him, we will have that to you all. Do you all have any questions? If not, thank you.

PSA Update:

The PSA has approximately 200 miles of water lines, 50 miles of gravity sewer lines, 25 miles of force main sewer line, 795 fire hydrants, 12 sewer pump stations, 12 water storage tanks, several wells and several water booster pump stations. The PSA's Water systems are as follows: Cana, Exit 1, Fancy Gap, Regional, Tower Road and Hillcrest Estates. The PSA's Sewer systems are as follows: Fancy Gap, Woodlawn, Gladeville/Cranberry, Hillsdale and Loves. All of this is operated and maintained with a staff of 13 people.

Old Business

Mr. Garry Jessup: Bob Armstrong did you ever get with him?

Mr. Doug Winesett: No Sir I have not had an opportunity too. If you would just have him call me.

Mr. Garry Jessup: I did.

Mrs. Dana Phillips: He came in and paid his connection fee.

Mr. Garry Jessup: He still wants to talk to you.

Mr. Doug Winesett: Okay I'll talk to most anybody as long as they don't have a ball bat. One thing I would like to touch on a little Dana is as everybody knows we have 5 of our members of the BOS here with us today, 3 of them currently sitting also on this board. There are couple items all the different departments, excuse me there is 6 (members) here. One of the situations we have got in over the years is we have some pieces of equipment that were bought several years ago we have a large tandem dump truck. As for the PSA's purposes we don't use it very much. But other departments do. I was told it was bought with grant money so we cannot dispose of it. I think we need Cellell monitoring the hours on it and spread the cost of maintenance out on it. And, we have a backhoe, that spent most of its time over at the land fill. Is that correct? And we also have a track hoe. Is that correct, we do? It is my perception that some of the other county's entities use these for their purposes. They should record the

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hours. I don't know what is y'all thoughts are? Should the PSA be compensated? I think we should at least share the maintenance. I'm am just thinking out loud.

Mr. Cellell Dalton: I can answer that. My thought is we need to set an hourly rate with an operator. I don't know if we are providing the operator or not. That should be the compensation. VDOT has an hourly book for rates. I think that can be part of the deal. I have told Dana before Carroll is an awful nice place at the end of the day bookkeeping in my world is at the end of the day somebody pay for it. There needs to be process or method out there, that I can't give away what the PSA has. I told you that. This has been done in the past. There needs to be a process. Some sort of paperwork or retribution. To be compensated for the vehicles somehow both ways.

Mr. Robbie McCraw: Do we just not use the backhoe? Do our guys not use it?

Mr. Doug Winesett: Robbie, basically now we are down personnel wise to where we are not really doing much construction. What I see it is repairs, maintenance and setting meters. And the small excavator.

Mr. Garry Jessup: Are we talking about the backhoe, the little backhoe for the track hoe?

Mr. Doug Winesett: Well we have a little excavator that we can haul behind a small truck that we use normally. And then we have a larger backhoe that stays mainly over at the land fill. And we also have a 311-track hoe, a large tandem dump truck and trailer. If we could have a motion to pursue setting rates on the pieces of equipment where the other county entities is concerned.

Mrs. Tracy Moore: I have a question. I was always under the understanding the excavators were bought partly like half from the county maintenance.

Mrs. Dana Phillips: I do not know I can't answer that. The dump truck was bought from the grant money from the Woodlawn sewer project. Of course, the mini and the sewer jetter all was from grant.

Mr. Tracy Moore: I just always heard that. I just wanted to clarify on that.

Mr. Doug Winesett: I guess we need to go back and investigate. I think it'd be fair that we do make a motion to pursue it.

Mr. Tracy Moore: I just want to make sure.

Mr. Garry Jessup: Can we table it until next meeting.

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Mrs. Doug Winesett: Can you look back on the records and see Dana? Anyone else?

Mr. Tracy Moore: I just always heard that. I just wanted to clarify on that.

AUTHORITY MEMBER'S TIME

Mr. Gary Jessup: What did y'all find on the financial committee Tracy and Robbie ? Y'all were on the committee to come up with refinancing or part of that.

Mr. Robbie McCraw: We have not discussed that yet with Mr. Dalton. He was going to get that information together and give it to us. We did meet with Dana on the budget. But we have not come up with a resolution to bring toward you all yet on refinancing.

Mr. Garry Jessup: Rates what are we going to do about that? There is no way that it will operate the way it is operating right now.

Mr. Doug Winesett: Dana would you like to address that?

Mrs. Dana Phillips: We are currently looking at the rates on all the exits and we are compiling our information for those exits and expenses for each exit.

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Mr. Gary Jessup: Is that what this was?

Mr. Dana Phillips: That was a proposed budget I sent to all the PSA members. That is a budget that was prepared before we had the cuts that we knew we were going to have. The first section is what it had always been in the past. Where we the Board had paid the New River Regional Water debt service and where we had the EDA availability fee in there. Then you have one budget that has the proposed change at New River Valley Regional Water the rate would change that is also in there. The other proposed budget is if we did not have the IDA or EDA agreements. So that is just a proposed budget that we have been working on.

Mr. Garry Jessup: We will have to establish a rate before this right?

Mrs. Dana Phillips: Yes, and we did have a meeting with Corbin Stone he is from Robinson, Farmer and Cox. He is going to get us a proposal back on doing a rate study for different areas of the county. We have not got those proposals back yet.

Mr. Phillip McCraw: I would like to thank them for being here with us this afternoon, the ladies for the work they do. And the board for the concern they have for doing the right thing. It is decision making, some of it will not be popular but I think it will be each one of us willing to do the right thing for the county and the people and I appreciate that.

Mr. Doug Winesett: Phillip that was well said, that's pretty much my feelings. I think theoretically we are headed in the same direction. Perhaps Joe you can give more insight that we are all in this together. And we will all hopefully work our way out of it together.

Mr. Robbie McCraw: I don't really have anything. I just appreciate what everyone's doing and hope we can continue to move forward.

Dr. Littrell: I don't really have anything either. I think we had a good meeting with good information, let's just keep moving forward.

Mr. Tracy Moore: Thank you to everyone for coming out. I do have a couple questions. On the grant that is repaid can we use the hourly labor and stuff as part of the match for that grant down there in Cana?

Mrs. Dana Phillips: Not that I am aware of.

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Mr. Tracy Moore: I know you wasn't able to meet with the board on the budget and all, is that going to be anytime soon? Do you have something scheduled with Cellell or something to go over?

Mrs. Dana Phillips: I guess that would be a question maybe Cellell can answer. I did copy him on the email that was sent to all of you all. And I would be glad to send it to Rex and Joe also. But if you want to meet that is fine.

Mr. Tracy Moore: I was just curious where we were at with it.

Mrs. Dana Phillips: Whatever the Boards or the BOS pleasure would be. I got sick on y'all after I left that night so. I hope I didn't get y'all sick.

Mr. Tracy Moore: It was Robbie.

Mr. Garry Jessup: Really, we can't do nothing about that until we establish a rate right for our budget?

Mrs. Dana Phillips: Rates will have to change to balance the budget, yes. But I do have those proposed budgets, and everyone is welcome to look at them. I'll be glad to meet with whoever wants to meet.

Mr. Tracy Moore: If it is something that Robbie and I need to meet with Cellell, as part of the financial we can. Whatever.

Mr. Robbie McCraw: Probably moving forward with the rates is going to be the primary thing.

Mr. Tracy Moore: That's all I got, thank you all for all that you do.

Mr. Doug Winesett: Anything else?

Mr. Cellell Dalton: If the finance board wants to be here, I have been talking to the health department about a free rate study out there. The health department has money, it seems that they will help fund a rate analyst for the PSA and hopefully we will know sometime this afternoon if she can be here Monday afternoon.

Mr. Tracy Moore: Thank you Cellell for all you do to help us too.

Chief Operators Notes

1. We have tested PAX XL-8 coagulant and found it to work well. I ordered a tanker load on 3/10/20 to start using for a solid test run and to most likely completely switch to for the rest of the year. I still plan to test other coagulants, but it'll be much easier now that the big tank is full. We should save around \$8,700 annually by this change.
2. We are signed up with Gov Deals to start posting surplus equipment on their online auction website. Currently:
 - a. We are also signed up with the state of Virginia's electronic procurement system. This will allow for us to get government bid pricing on select items and services.
3. Mr. Post's retirement will impact us greatly. It is necessary to hire someone quickly.
 - a. By the budget staff calculator, after April 30, 2020, we will be staffed to operate a maximum of 11.3 hours/day if I assume Rick's vacancy, and 8.9 hours/day if not. Both numbers are under the February average of 13.31 hours/day, and of which 10 days were 14-16+ hours. The operator numbers include our part time operator as 0.7 of an employee but do not take in to account the availability to pair a classed operator with a trainee.
 - b. Using last year average of 12.4 hours/day operation and the figures above it would require between 923 - 2,938 man hours (2 ops. per shift/15% leave time) of overtime to maintain average. This would be increased as this year's average is higher so far.
 - c. Our current ad for a class 1-2 operator has been out over 4 months (11/7/19).
 - d. This year, we have turned in a total of approximately 43 hours over 40/week. I recommend us to be staffed for 16 hour days to help cover maximum days and the recent budget draft reflects this with the additional trainee position.
 - e. A major issue we're facing is getting a classed applicant to apply and the time it takes for someone to become a class 2 or higher operator. We have some excellent trainee candidates, but we're at not in a position to hire them until we have enough classed operators.
4. I request permission to post a part time job ad to offer local classed operators the opportunity to help us in our situation. There is interest from people I've spoken with, but I feel we need to be in the \$20-25/hour range to have good pool of class 2-1 operators to work with.
5. VSC was onsite 3/10/20 to do our quarterly sprinkler, fire extinguisher, and annual backflow device inspections. The water bell is the only item found that wasn't working correctly.
6. Raw Pump #1 was pulled on 3/13/20 by F&R Electric to be rebuilt.

Chairman Sutherland led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

RE: CONSENT AGENDA

Chairman Sutherland presented the Consent Agenda consisting of the minutes of the regular meeting of January 16, 2020 to the Authority members for approval. Chairman Sutherland inquired if there was any discussion on the minutes as presented. There being none, Mr. Dalton made a motion, which was seconded by Mr. Horney to approve the Consent Agenda consisting of the minutes of the special meeting of January 16, 2020 as presented. The motion passed unanimously with all members present voting to approve the Consent Agenda, as presented.

RE: CITIZENS' TIME

Chairman Sutherland inquired if there were any citizens present with topics of discussion during the meeting. There being none, Chairman Sutherland proceeded with the agenda.

Chairman Sutherland inquired if there was any discussion on the invoices presented. There being none, Chairman Sutherland inquired if there was a motion to approve payment of the invoices. The motion passed unanimously with all members present voting to approve payment of the invoices, as presented.

RE: CHIEF OPERATOR'S REPORT

Chairman Sutherland advised that the next agenda item is the Chief Operator's Report. He then turned the meeting over to Mr. Slate.

Mr. Slate reported on the following:

1. We have had communication failures with the Raw Pump station intermittently on 1/20/2020 the Raw pumps had to be started at the river and we regained communication later that day. The next day was the same, but it never came back. After talking to Roger, with American Mine Research, and Citizens Internet we were able to resolve it. It was an internet service provider issue. We had a similar issue occur multiple times. Citizens Internet was able to correct each time. Citizens found a hole in part of their line and a unit that was bad.
2. We cleaned out the sediment in our coagulant tank. We have been running out of a temporary tote. To test coagulant PAX XL-8 in the plant.
3. Our flow meters readings were verified on 1/23/2020 by Instrumentation Services Inc. We have shipped back an inline turbidity meter that is covered under warranty to be repaired. Installed raw water turbidity meter 2/14/20
4. Mr. Eric Herold was onsite for an inspection on 2/4/20. Overall the inspection was positive. Most everything was corrected from his previous list. Currently our loss of head gauges need to be calibrated. We will have to replace a small pressure gauge or 2 and have the readings synced with the SCADA system. Conversations later in the week with Eric resulted in testing changes that will save us money in lab chemicals as well as easier testing.
5. Water demand has increased. It seems to be an on and off pattern varying by the week. We have produced 1.24 MG (Million Gallons) more this January and on track to produce 5.9 MG this month compared to last February. Refer to capacity sheet.
6. Brenntag is now manufacturing sodium hypochlorite or closer to our facility. We're going to save \$105/load for a total savings of around \$525/year. There is a chance it will go even cheaper.

7. 2 operators are scheduled to attend the Wytheville Community College class in March to get the continuing education credits needed to keep their waterworks operator license.
8. There was a high water event that started on 2/6/20. The town plant was shut down later that night so we worked late. On 2/7/20 the Town's intake clogged up causing them to shut their plant down again. Later they used pumps to bypass the clog so they could operate. Discussion was made about Town of Wytheville employees working at NRRWA a 3rd shift to help out us both out. There were concerns as to how pay and how insurance would work. It was decided to not use this option unless necessary. I believe if the Town does become our fiscal agent it will be a more feasible option for future emergencies. We were able to operate some extended hours as permitted to help in this event.

Discussion was made about a mutual aid agreement.

9. HVAC was repaired on 2/12/20. I contacted a company to inspect it and they found a wire loose and proceeded to corrected it.
10. Austinville Pump Station was left on night of Feb. 8th, 2020. Bill was from average usage minus the 8th and 9th.
11. One pH controller messed up and is obsolete. We have four (4) of these units. Could we use money from "Outside Professional Services" and/or what is left in "dechlor" which we think we have solved?
12. Rick Post, almost 10 year employee, handed in his retirement resignation [letter] this morning effective April 30, 2020. We need be aggressive in finding a replacement.

Chairman Sutherland inquired if there were any question or comments for Mr. Slate. There being none, he proceeded with the agenda.

RE: BOARD TIME

Chairman Sutherland discussed the capacity allocation and the NRRWA board arrangement with newly appointed board member Mr. Terry and turned to meeting over to Mr. Peed.

Mr. Peed reported an update on the DEQ (Department of Environmental Quality) withdrawal permit.

Chairman Sutherland inquired if there was a motion to accept the audit. A motion was made by Mr. Bear and seconded by Mr. Dalton to accept the audit.. The motion passed unanimously with all members present voting to approve payment of the invoices, as presented.

Chairman Sutherland proceeded with the next item of budget development. Discussion was made to meet with the budget committee to discuss the first draft budget.

Mr. Bear reported about possibly adding an emergency water connection to Rural Retreat. There was discussion about implementing this connection.

RE: ADJOURNMENT

Chairman Sutherland inquired if there was any other business to come before the Authority. There being none, he carried to adjourn the meeting at 10:26 a.m.
