

OFFICIAL MINUTES

June 6, 2016

The Carroll County Electoral Board met on June 6, 2016 at 8:30 A.M. in the Board Room at the Carroll County Governmental Center. Chairman Shockley called the meeting to order.

Present were Dennie Shockley, Chairman; Brenda Lindsey, Vice Chairman; and Brenda Diamond, Secretary, and Kimberly Cloud, General Registrar.

The Board discussed changes in Woodlawn and Oakland precinct setups. To reduce voter confusion, the Board decided to check with the Department of Elections to see if only one check in station with multiple laptops could be used at Woodlawn and Oakland for all precincts at the November 8, 2016 election. The Board decided to check with the Department when attending the Uniformity Workshop in Richmond in June.

The Board performed the annual review of the General Registrar, which was followed by discussion with the Registrar.


Discussion was held on the telephone bills for precincts at Mt. Bethel, Lambsburg, Sylvatus, and Vaughan. The bills received for the March Primary Elections were higher than from previous elections and contact has been made with Century Link billing department to investigate excess charges.

The Board discussed the 2016-2017 budget. The Board will make every effort to be conservative with this year's budget.

Discussion was held about a check list for Election Officials.
