Come enjoy an afternoon of family fun in one of our picnic shelters at Carroll County Recreation Park. Plan a birthday party, family reunion, or group event under the cool shade of a shelter. Restrooms, picnic tables, trash cans, electricity, and charcoal grills are provided.



Shelters may be reserved – to reserve a shelter, please call or come by the Carroll County Recreation Office during business hours. Shelters are reserved on first-come, first served basis. Fees are as follows:

One Shelter: \$35.00 up to 4 hours All Day: \$70.00 Two Shelters: \$70.00 up to 4 hours All Day: \$140.00



The Carter Pines Picnic Shelter is located at 215 E Grayson St, Hillsville, VA 24343. Reservations must be made at CCRD. This facility has no charge for use of the shelter.

Park Hours of Operation

April–October: 8:30 am–8:30 pm November– March: 8:30 am–5:30 pm

Restrooms are open April-October

Pets

No pets are permitted on park grounds.

Litter and Debris

All shelter areas must be left free of litter and debris. Confetti is not allowed at any shelter. Before departure, please place all garbage in trash receptacles.

Amplified Music

Amplified music is not allowed in the park. Small radios are allowed, but the music must not disturb others in the park.

Alcoholic Beverages

Alcoholic beverages are prohibited!

Baseball Program


