### LEGISLATION

**1. FIRST READING:**

An Ordinance authorizing the City to participate in the Ohio Department of Transportation Cooperative Purchasing Program for road salt.

**2. FIRST READING:**

An Ordinance supporting a Community Yard Sale to be held the weekend of Friday, June 4, 2021 through Sunday, June 6, 2021 and waiving the yard sale permit fee of five dollars (\$5.00) for that weekend.

**3. FIRST READING:**

An Ordinance re-appropriating \$8,000.00 for use toward the purchase of decorative sleeves and other necessary items for updating parking meters and declaring an emergency.

**4. FIRST READING:**

An Ordinance accepting insurance reimbursement funds in the amount of \$12,370.00, re-appropriating \$14,870.00 for the total cost of replacement and repair of a traffic signal control panel and declaring an emergency.

**5. FIRST READING:**

A Resolution authorizing the City of Chillicothe, hereinafter referred to as the Local Public Agency (LPA), to prepare and execute an application for the Safe Routes to School Project and declaring an emergency.

**6. FIRST READING:**

A Resolution supporting the Ross County Parks District in its application for Clean Ohio Trails Fund (COTF) and Recreational Trails Program (RTP) grants funds and declaring an emergency.
