LEGISLATION

1. FIRST READING:

An Ordinance to make appropriation for current expenses and other expenditures of the City of Chillicothe, State of Ohio, during the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2023, and ending December 31, 2023, and declaring an emergency.

2. FIRST READING:

An Ordinance appropriating funds for the purpose of making payroll, fringe and pensions for the remainder of 2022 and declaring an emergency.

3. FIRST READING:

An Ordinance providing for an agreement between the City of Chillicothe, Ohio and the Ross County Commissioners, whereby the City of Chillicothe, Ohio, will continue to be eligible through 2023 for state reimbursement of costs incurred in appointing counsel for Indigent Criminal Defendants and declaring an emergency.

4. FIRST READING:

An Ordinance amending Section 521.17(a) titled “Maximum Height of Grass and Weeds” of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Chillicothe and declaring an emergency.

5. FIRST READING:

An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of Chillicothe to enter into a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) Agreement on behalf of the City of Chillicothe for construction of wastewater facilities, designating a dedicated repayment source for the loan and declaring an emergency.

6. FIRST READING:

An Ordinance removing unnecessary appropriations from the books of the City of Chillicothe for various funds and declaring an emergency.
