LEGISLATION

1. THIRD READING:

A Resolution expressing cooperation and granting use of a certain portion of Paint Street to the downtown Chillicothe Organization for its Yellow Day celebration on May 6th, 2022.

2. THIRD READING:

A Resolution granting the use of the City Park and surrounding streets from Thursday May 26th, 2022, at 8:00 AM through Monday May 30th, 2022, at 11:00 AM for the preparation, operation and cleanup of the annual Feast of the Flowering Moon and providing for coordination of its events with the city Parks and Recreation department.

3. SECOND READING:

An ordinance accepting and appropriating \$10, 242.60 received from the recycling of scrap water meters for the use toward replacing other aged meters in the City's water distribution system.

4. SECOND READING:

A Resolution expressing cooperation and granting use of a portion of Paint Street to the 50 West Brewing Company for the 50 West Half Marathon Sunday June 5th, 2022.

5. FIRST READING:

An Ordinance accepting and appropriating \$2,500.00 received from the Ohio Forestry Association.

6. FIRST READING:

An ordinance appropriating \$11,000.00 to purchase a Computer Voice Stress Analysis III System for the Chillicothe Police Department.

7. FIRST READING:

An Ordinance consenting to an Ohio Enterprise Zone and Tax Abatement Agreement between the city of Chillicothe OH and J. C. Properties of Chillicothe, LLC DBA Chillicothe Steel.

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8. FIRST READING:

A Resolution authorizing the filing of applications with the Ohio Department of Transportation(ODOT) for grants through the U.S. DOT Federal Transit Administration (FTA) as authorized under Federal Transit Laws, as codified, 49 USC Section 5311, Formula Grants for rural areas, and the Ohio Transit Partnership (OTP2) program grant, both in Ohio’s Rural Transportation Program and grants authorized under Federal Transit Laws, as codified, 49 US section 5339, Grants for Buses and Bus Facilities, Ohio Bus and Bus Facilities Transportation Program, accepting such grants if awarded, executing a contract with ODOT upon project approval, and declaring an emergency
