LEGISLATION

1. Third reading – Res - Supporting the purchase of property located at 400 East Seventh Street, authorizing the Administration to pursue financing for the property in an amount not to exceed \$2,150,000.00 with an interest rate not to exceed 3%, which financing shall include costs related to demolition of certain buildings, equipment, and design costs.
2. Second reading – Ord - Authorizing the issuance of not to exceed \$2,000,000 Building Acquisition and Improvement Bonds for the purpose of paying the cost of acquiring and improving a building together with all necessary appurtenances.
3. Second reading – Ord - Authorizing the issuance of not to exceed \$150,000 Vehicle and Equipment Acquisition Bonds for the purpose of vehicle and equipment acquisition, together with all necessary appurtenances thereto.
4. Second reading – Ord - Consolidating two bond issues of the City of Chillicothe, Ohio.
5. Second reading – Res - Granting use of Yoctangee Park and certain city streets for the Annual Jaycees & Evening Lions Halloween Parade on Saturday, October 26, 2019.
6. First reading – Ord - Appropriating \$275,280.00 for various expenses within the Water and Sewer Departments, approving the redistribution of previously approved capital funds within the Water and Sewer Departments.
7. First reading – Ord - Relating to fees the City of Chillicothe Water Department will charge for water taps, user capacity fees, and other special services and repealing Ordinance 74-02.
8. First reading – Ord - Adopting the revised Utility Department Rules & Regulations, replacing the current Rules & Regulations.
9. First reading – Ord - Allowing the City Auditor to transfer appropriated dollars between salaries and fringes within the same fund if needed on an emergency basis for the remainder of the year 2019.
10. First reading – Ord - Authorizing the expenditure of funds in the amount of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00) for computers for the Chillicothe Municipal Court.
11. Reconsideration – Ord – Ord. No. 85-19 accepting a donation from the AMVETS Council for the Memorial Park.
