**LEGISLATION**

1. Third reading – Ord - Authorizing the Mayor to enter into an easement agreement with the Atomic Credit Union.
2. Second reading – Ord - Appropriating funds in the amount of \$10,000.00 for use by the Fire Department for vehicle repair and fuel usage for the remainder of 2019.
3. Second reading – Ord - Appropriating \$35,266.03 from various funds to upgrade security at all City buildings.
4. First reading – Ord - Transferring Landfill Capital Funds for use toward mower repair costs.
5. First reading – Ord - Accepting donations totaling \$82,208.45 and appropriating said funds for use in the development and creation of the Dog Park.
6. First reading – Ord - Suspending the maximum hours established for one part-time security officer and one part-time deputy bailiff to allow for their services for the remainder of 2019.
7. First reading – Ord - Extending the Chillicothe Municipal Court Victim Witness Assistance Program, accepting grant monies received through the Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) and the State Victims Assistance Act (SVAA).
