LEGISLATION

1. Second reading – Ord - Relating to fees the City of Chillicothe Water Department will charge for water taps, user capacity fees, and other special services and repealing Ordinance 74-02.
2. Second reading – Ord - Adopting the revised Utility Department Rules & Regulations, replacing the current Rules & Regulations.
3. First reading – Ord - Amending Ordinance 53-11 for the purpose of clarifying the joint venture agreement between the City of Chillicothe and the Ross County Park District for the operation and maintenance of the Donald F. Coppel Athletic Complex.
4. First reading – Ord - Authorizing participation by the Chillicothe Municipal Drug Court in the Ohio Mental Health and Addiction Services (OMHAS) Addiction Treatment Program, accepting and appropriating \$708.98 received from OMHAS.
5. First reading – Ord - Appropriating funds in the amount of \$10,000.00 for use by the Fire Department for vehicle repair and fuel usage for the remainder of 2019.
6. First reading – Ord - Accepting and appropriating grant funds in the amount of \$8,400.00 for use by the Fire Department.
7. First reading – Ord - Appropriating \$35,266.03 from various funds to upgrade security at all City buildings.
8. First reading – Ord - Appropriating \$975,000.00 for use toward the purchase of property located at 400 East Seventh Street.
9. First reading – Ord - Appropriating funds in the amount of \$4,671.20 for the purchase of equipment for the Information Technology Department, reimbursing the Mayor's Office for expenditures already incurred.
10. First reading – Ord - Providing for an agreement between the City of Chillicothe, Ohio and the Ross County Commissioners, whereby the City of Chillicothe, Ohio, will continue to be eligible through 2020 for State reimbursement of costs incurred in appointing counsel for indigent criminal defendants.
